

Enrollment Headcounts for Los Angeles Bachelor of Fine Arts Students

How to read these tables:

These tables show the Enrollment Headcounts for students who enrolled in the Los Angeles Bachelor of Fine Arts programs on the AMDA Los Angeles Campus. LA BFA programs include Bachelor of Fine Arts in Acting, Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Theatre, Bachelor of Fine Arts in Music Theatre, and Bachelor of Fine Arts in Performing Arts.

Students are grouped by enrollment cohort, by prior education, by self-identified gender, and by self-identified race/ethnicity.

An enrollment cohort groups all students who started their enrollment in a given term or a given year.

• For example, 18 students started a Los Angeles BFA program during the Spring 2013 term; 206 students started a Los Angeles BFA program in 2013.

These tables include only students who pursued a single enrollment at AMDA. Students who changed their campus or program during their academic careers are represented in different tables.

- Prior Education:
 - 1 Enrollment: These are students whose education experience just prior to enrollment may include: High School Diploma, Home School Diploma, Foreign High School, GED.
 - Transfer: These are students whose education experience just prior to enrollment may include: some college, Foreign college, Associates degree, Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, Post-secondary degree..

All LA BFA Students

- Rate: the proportion of 1st enrollment or Transfer students compared to the total. For example, in 2013, 82% of BFA students enrolled as 1st enrollment students and 18% enrolled as Transfer students.
- Terms are abbreviated: Spring (SP), Summer (SU), Fall (F).
