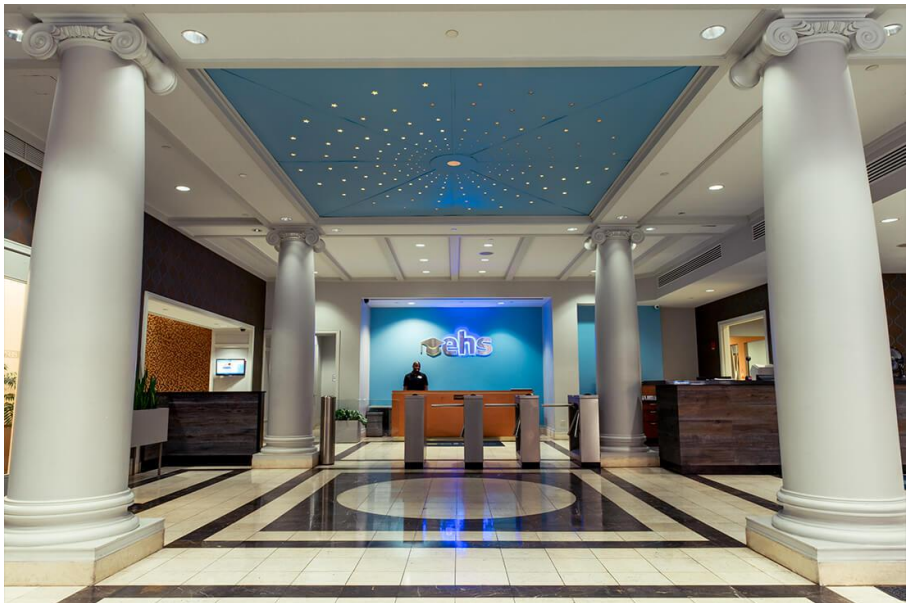

About St. George Towers

One stop to Manhattan and minutes to Wall Street, **St. George Towers** mixes the convenience of Manhattan residences with Brooklyn charm. Once the largest hotel in New York, **St. George Towers** is made up of three towers (Clark, Studio and Weller), each featuring access to an enormous community center. With a communal kitchen, study room, screening room, pool table, and flat screen TVs, you'll enjoy college life in one of New York's most coveted neighborhoods. Educational Housing Services (EHS), where AMDA students will be living at **St. George Towers** and the **New Yorker**, is monitored by security 24/7. EHS partners with schools to provide all-inclusive contract housing. Other schools will be placed in the building along with AMDA students.

Brooklyn Heights is a posh residential area of elegant brownstones. It's known for its tree-lined promenade along the East River, with unrivaled views of Manhattan and the Statue of Liberty. The neighborhood also attracts visitors and local families to the landscaped walkways and playgrounds of waterfront Brooklyn Bridge Park. Locals gather at the longstanding restaurants along Henry Street.

St. George Towers contains a communal kitchen with 5 stove tops, access to convection ovens and multiple microwaves, Wi-Fi, card-operated laundry facilities, and 24-hour security. All students must show their EHS ID to gain entry into the hotel.

St. George Towers is a 2-minute walk to the Clark Street subway stop, making it exceptionally convenient when it comes to accessing the subway. Once on the train, the commute is only 30 minutes (or less!) to AMDA's 61st and 54th street buildings.

WHAT WILL MY MOVE-IN PROCESS LOOK LIKE?

On move-in day, please report directly to **St. George Towers** at your scheduled appointment time (sent in a separate email) to begin the process of moving in. When you arrive at our 55 Clark street entrance, please let security know you are here to move-in.

- After your check-in with staff is complete, bins are available to assist you move-in. When you are finished using a moving bin, please return it to the designated area in the lobby.
- If you arrive by car, do not leave your car unattended and follow street signs closely. The parking around the residence is managed by the city and you can be ticketed by NYPD.
- After you have unloaded your car, you can find nearby street or garage parking.

Students are welcome to arrive with guests to assist with move-in, but no more than two people! Please note that there may be changes that affect housing move-in and visitor access on campus. If there are any changes to this they will be communicated in as much notice as possible. Additionally, everyone will be required to show identification.



- 1** Arrive at your residence hall at your designated arrival time (link sent in your Housing Assignment email).
- 2** Unload and move your vehicle (if applicable) to make way for other residents, borrowing an available moving bin if needed.
- 3** Upon entry into the building you will receive your room key and Move-In Form, which will officially check you into the building.
- 4** Unload all items into your room and return the moving bin to the designated area in the lobby.

Things to Note:



We recommend only bringing enough personal items to manage in one trip into the building



Please utilize the stairs whenever possible, as elevators will be delayed!



Be prepared for all weather!

RECOMMENDED PACKING AND SHIPPING LISTS

We strongly recommend that students ship items ahead of time and only bring with them what they can carry. Items should arrive at the residence hall no sooner than the **Monday before move-in**. All students can send items to:

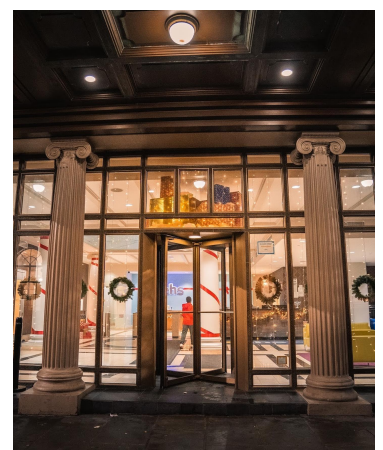
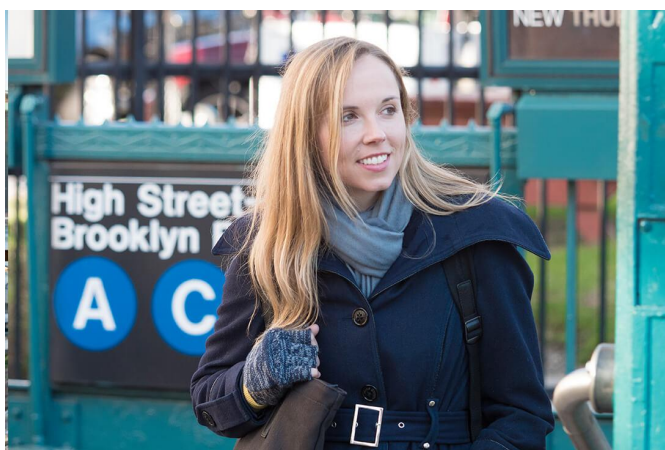

We suggest students bring the following:

- › Seasonal clothing and shoes
- › Toiletries
- › Medical and personal care items (prescription and other medications)
- › Chargers for your devices and extension cords

We suggest students ship the following and/or obtain after arrival:

- › Linens, sheets, pillows, and towels (bed sizes are normal, single twins, not extra-long)
- › Non-perishable food
- › Books/school materials
- › Trash bags
- › Yoga mat, small weights/exercise bands, and massage balls/foam rollers
- › Reusable Ice Packs
- › Entertainment items (art supplies, puzzles, E-readers, etc.)



ROOM FEATURES AND AMENITIES

All units are fully furnished with regular twin-size beds, under-bed dresser units (two per student), and a desk with chair. Each room features a private bathroom, closet, flatscreen tv with complimentary cable, as well as wi-fi, available in all rooms and common areas.

- Please observe all signage and hours of operations.



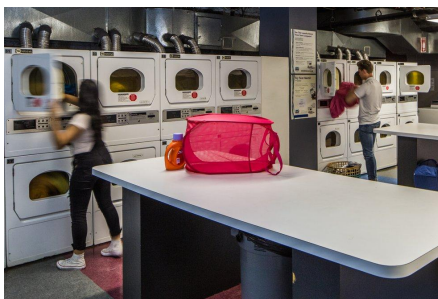
Game/Lounge Area

- Students must first purchase a \$5 card that is yours to keep.
