Musical Theatre: Course Descriptions

Musical Theatre Fundamentals: Teaches students the core elements of musical theatre; including acting, vocal and physical techniques that improve their skills as a triple threat.

Musical Theatre Audition Techniques: Class dedicated to learning the ins-and-outs of how to audition for a college/conservatory program, culminating in a self tape audition the student submits for AMDA college.

Performance Principles: Students are assigned material to prepare for their final presentation and use the class time to work with faculty on their group pieces.

Performing Arts Experience: Classes covering derivatives of their core discipline, giving performers training in a range of techniques.

Admission Audition Information Session: The AMDA admissions team takes students through the college audition process in order to help them successfully produce a self tape submission.

Breakout Sessions / Private Instructions: Students have the opportunity to have one-on-one instruction with their faculty as well as sessions with their classmates, coordinated by our program facilitators.

Independent Rehearsals: Time dedicated toward students independent practice on assigned work from faculty.

Independent Lesson Plans: Time dedicated toward independent learning with pre-set lessons and assignments.

Guest Speakers: AMDA Alumni, currently working professionally in their field, give students a chance to ask questions and gain insight.

Presentation Watch Party: The final presentations are broadcasted during the last day of the session for students, friends and family members.

Summer Grooves Watch Party: Students have an opportunity to audition and perform in a talent show made by the students and for the students in the program.

Broadway Watch Party: Our students have the opportunity to virtually watch a Broadway show together with the faculty and gain a glimpse into the professional industry.
